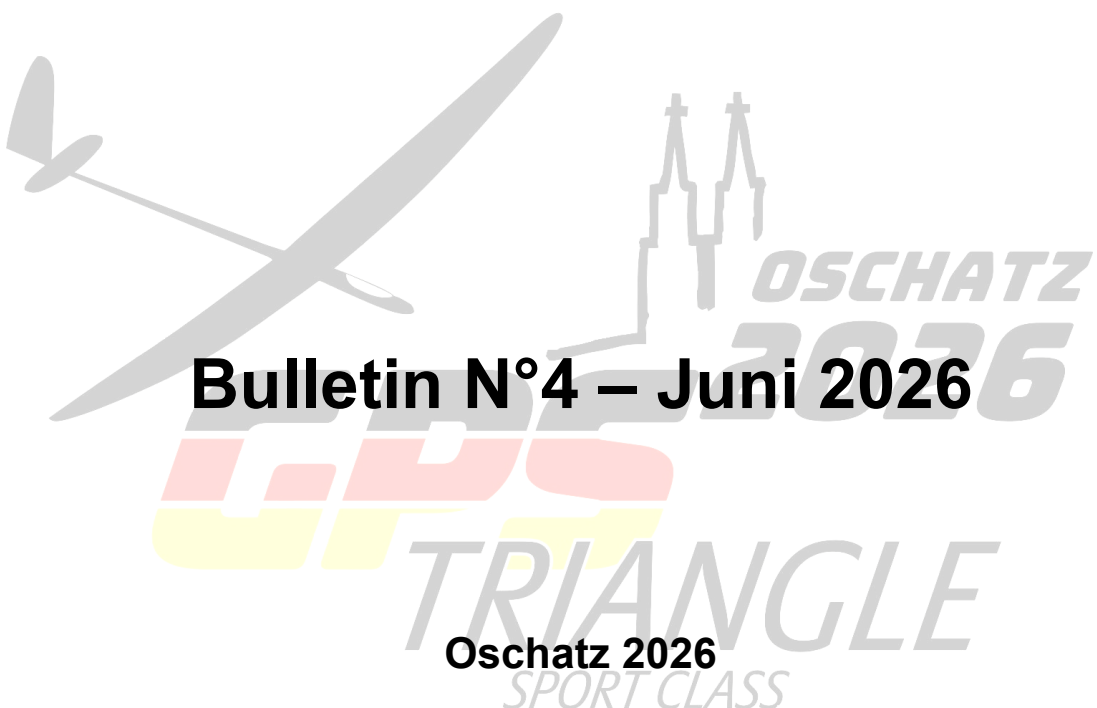

6. Regulations / Entry fees / Registration

All regulations are available for download under: www.gps-triangle.net.

The valid rules for the Scale Class is Version 1.9 (February 2026)

Free flying is possible outside of the official competition flights (morning and evening) after consultation of airport flight control.

Entry Fees are specified as follows:

- 240,00 EUR per Competitor (registration till 30th of April 2026)
- 300,00 EUR per competitor (registration till 30th of June 2026)

The Registration procedure is online. You can register on www.rcmodelsport.com.

7. Necessary documents and model marking

- Insurance
- EASA Identification number(eID-number) visibly marked on the model airplanes
- Proof of knowledge(“Kenntnisnachweis”) or training certificate (“Schulungsnachweis”) will be checked before opening

These documents are mandatory, flying without these documents will NOT BE POSSIBLE! Every competitor is allowed to use 2 models in the competition. Models will be marked with small stickers (stickers are available at the field).

We recommend that foreign pilots from overseas register as guest pilots with the “Modellflugsportverband Deutschland e.V. (MFSD)”. The registration is valid for 3 months from the date of registration. This 3-month trial membership (“Probemitgliedschaft”) with MFSD includes liability insurance and registration of the EASA Identification number (eID) for 5 Euro. The organization team will be happy to help you fill out the form. Please send your data to Rlosemann@aol.com (full name, birthday, address, Email, phone number) Latest Deadline end of May The money will be collected on the airfield.

EASA Identification number (eID) Every pilot is self-responsible for this part!

From May 1, 2021, all unmanned aircraft (including model aircraft) within the European Union must be marked with the personal registration number (eID). The legislator has not imposed any special requirements on the method of marking. A QR code is permissible. The number can also be placed inside the model. eID of other countries within the European Union are recognized.

Proof of knowledge (“Kenntnisnachweis”) / training certificate (“Schulungsnachweis”):
In Germany, a proof of knowledge (“Kenntnisnachweis”) / training certificate (“Schulungsnachweis”) is mandatory required to operate a model aircraft at altitudes of more than 120 meters above ground or with a take-off weight of more than 2 kilograms. This applies to flying on and off model airfields. This proof of knowledge / training certificate certifies that the owner has knowledge of the basics of the use and navigation of model aircraft, the relevant legal principles and the local airspace regulations. Members of association of other EU and non-EU countries, as well as model pilots who are not members of an association, therefore require an obligatory certificate of knowledge from the DMFV <https://kenntnisnachweisonline.dmfv.aero/> or a training certificate from the MFSD

The DMFV certificate of knowledge or the MFSD training certificate is valid for 5 years and cost around 30 EURO including VAT.

8. Teams

- Team partners must be selected until 1st of August on www.rcmodelsport.com
If there is no team partner selected, the team constellations will be undertaken by the organizer.
- For the navigation devices fixed channels will be used! The channels are selected by the organizer.

9. Groups

- Current plans are to fly heats consisting of 4 groups with maximum 12 competitors per group
- First group will start at 08:30 am, last group will start around 6 pm each day. Heats will not necessarily need to be completed at the end of each competition day. Lunchtime 30 minutes.

10. Task and safety zones

Task will be provided at www.rcmodelsport.com / July 2026. Safety zones will be defined in the task file. Maximum altitude: 750 m AGL. Two landing directions will be available. The landing direction will be announced according to the prevailing wind direction

12. Official Language

The official language is English.

13. Frequencies

RC-Systems at 2.4 GHz are recommended. The 2.4 GHz transmitters have to comply with European Standard EN 300328. The maximum equivalent emission power EIRP to be 100mW peak. The transmitter must be CE marked and show the declaration of conformity.

14. Evaluation and Results

- The World Championships will be evaluated online via rcmodelsport.com. Prepare your login and familiarize yourself with this website. All flights should be uploaded after each heat.

The Albatross Software **4.4.4** is mandatory. (maby changes up to the competition)

Unauthorized using of motor will be checked frequently by the organizer.

15. Successions

A minimum of 6 rounds for a scoring will be flown. We will try to fly as many rounds as possible.

16. Medical Care

It is strongly recommended to all competitors that They have insurance which covers them for medical expenses and repatriation in the case of injury.

17. Health-Insurance

Participants should provide their own health insurance to cover accidents and illness.

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be available all the time at the airfield.
